ALL-PURPOSE

Casey Barnes, 6-2, 205 Senior, Homestead

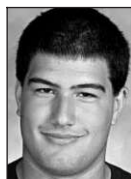
Two-year starter at quarterback and two-time all-North Shore Conference punter also handled all placements for extra points and field goals and occasionally kicked off for 12-0 Highlanders ... tremendous leader with 24-2 career record ... completed 98 of 159 passes (62 percent) for 1,718 yards and 16 touchdowns with only six interceptions for run-oriented team ... averaged 40.2 yards per punt with less than a yard return.



GUARD

David Horner-Ibler 6-1, 250, Junior Brookfield Central

First-team all-Greater Metro Conference selection ... on scale of 1 to 4, with 4 being tops, he graded out at 4s in drive blocking, pull and trap rating, reach blocking, pull and lead rating and pass blocking ... one of major reasons Central's Xavier Whitaker was co-Offensive Player of Year in GMC.



GUARD

Justin Barber, 6-0, 225 Junior, Homestead

First-team All-North Shore Conference selection for 12-0 Highlanders and one of five new position players on offensive front for team that averaged 37 points a game ... smart, athletic player who was state qualifier in discus last spring.



GUARD

Andy Gaber 6-3, 230 Senior New Berlin Eisenhower

Helped Lions run for 1,760 yards, pass for 1,789 and score 26 touchdowns ... four-year varsity starter was first-team all-Woodland Conference in each of past two seasons.

The 2008 Community Newspapers All-Suburban Player of Year, Woodland Conference Offensive Player of Year and all-region pick ... one of three Gatorade Wisconsin Player of Year finalists ... made 49 catches for 925 yards and 16 touchdowns, averaged 16.7 yards on punt returns with one TD and 24.6 on kickoff returns. ... according to coach Rob Stoltz, Ericksen is state leader in TD receptions.



KICKER

Anthony Leonardelli 6-1, 180, Senior West Allis Hale

Hit 33 of 36 extra-point tries, converted two of five field-goal attempts, executed three onside kicks, averaged 45 yards per kickoff.



END

Barret Powell, 6-3, 200 Junior, Wauwatosa East

First-team all-Greater Metro Conference selection and co-GMC Offensive Player of Year ... caught school-record 52 passes to break mark he and DJ Cupertino set last season.



TIGHT END

Derric Junakin, 6-3, 240 Junior, Cudahy

First-team all-Woodland Conference pick ... led Packers with 30 catches for 474 yards (15.8 per catch) and six touchdowns ... quick for a big fellow, he often outran defensive backs ... one of his touchdown receptions went for 70 yards.



TACKLE

Evan Rosa, 6-3, 288 Junior, West Allis Hale

Rosa totaled 21 pancake blocks ... keyed strong offensive line that paved way for 2,910 yards rushing and 745 passing for 3,655 total, an average of 365 per game ... Hale led GMC in total yards and rushing yardage.



QUARTERBACK

Chris Ridgway, 6-1, 195 Senior, Greendale

All-Woodland and all-region pick ... completed 90 of 145 passes for 1,511 yards and 20 touchdowns, ran 91 times for 422 yards (and five TDs).



CENTER

Joe Hansen, 6-1, 255 Senior, Greendale

All-Woodland Conference pick for Panthers, who reached Level 3 of WIAA Division 3 playoffs ... made no errant snaps from center in high-powered shotgun offense ... allowed just one sack in two seasons.



TACKLE

Jake Thiel, 6-2, 285 Senior, Oak Creek

First team all-Southeast Conference ... team captain has 3.9 grade-point average ... coach Mike Bartholomew calls him best offensive lineman he has coached in 24 years of coaching high school and college.



TACKLE

Jake Holterman, 6-3, 285 Senior, Muskego

First-team all-Southeast Conference choice and team MVP helped Warriors rush for 2,012 yards and pass for 467 ... Coach rated him a 4 in drive blocking, pull and trap blocking, reach blocking, pull and lead blocking.



ALL-PURPOSE

Mike Picciolo, 5-9, 175 Senior, Greendale

Voted all-Woodland Conference at wide receiver and in secondary and all-region at defensive back ... made 37 catches for 504 yards and six TDs on offense, 29 solo tackles and 15 assists with one interception as defensive back ... averaged 14.6 yards on punt returns with one TD and 22.6 yards per kickoff return.



RUNNING BACK

Alex Roy 5-10, 185 Senior, Muskego

Carried 214 times for 1,360 yards (6.3 avg.) and 10 touchdowns and caught five passes for 35 yards ... made major breakthrough after carrying just twice for 2 yards last season ... second-leading rusher in Southeast Conference behind Racine Park's Deon McLain ... rushed for over 200 yards three times and over 100 yards in eight of nine games.



RUNNING BACK

Will Frisch, 5-8, 175 Senior, St. Francis

All-Woodland Conference and all-region selection ... rushed 281 times for 1,738 yards (6.19 avg.) and 14 touchdowns ... set school record for rushing yards ... ranked second among area rushers to Deon McLain of Racine Park ... opponents knew what was coming and still could not stop him.



RUNNING BACK

Jordan Biller, 5-9, 205 Senior, Greendale

All-Woodland Conference pick carried 120 times for 1,051 yards (8.7 avg.) and 12 TDs ... seemed to get stronger as year went along and provided balance to Greendale's attack ... became first Greendale running back to rush for 1,000 yards since 2000.
